Post Title: Teacher of Physical Education with Sports Studies to KS3, KS4 and KS5

Purpose of Job:

- To teach practical PE to KS3 and KS4.
- To teach Exam PE at KS4.
- To teach PE/Sports Studies to KS5 Students.
- To teach at least one other subject outside of PE specialism.

Major Tasks:

- Preparing, planning and teaching Physical Education across a range of abilities at KS3 and KS4.
- Preparing, planning and teaching examination Physical Education at KS4.
- Preparing, planning and teaching Sports Studies to KS5 Students.
- Preparing, planning and teaching small groups of pupils to address individual learning needs.
- To liaise with the Head of Physical Education and work collaboratively with others, to support the delivery of Physical Education and Sports Studies at KS3, KS4 and KS5.
- To use ICT to enhance Learning and Teaching.
- To manage relevant resources under the direction of the Principal, and to organise and attend departmental and other meetings as required.
- To monitor and evaluate curriculum innovation and delivery.
- To assess and monitor pupil progress and performance through classwork, homework and examination, and to implement school and statutory assessment, record and report internally and externally.
- To develop and implement a range of strategies and initiatives to raise standards.
- To oversee the differentiated needs of learners across Key Stages.
- To maintain good order and positive behaviour among pupils in accordance with school policies.
- To act as Form Teacher with associated Pastoral Care duties.
- To actively encourage, promote, contribute to, coach extra-curricular / after-school activities relevant to the Physical Education Department / within the College.
- To develop and implement new approaches and initiatives within the Physical Education Department, alongside whole school professional learning.
- To undertake supervisory duties, rotas and other duties as requested by the Principal.

Reporting Relationships

- Report to the relevant Head of Department.
- As Form Teacher, to work with Head of Year.
- To report to the Principal, Senior Leadership Team and External Agencies as required.

Activities:

Preparing/planning/teaching:

- Planning and preparing lessons.
- Teaching, according to educational needs, the pupils assigned to him/her, including the setting and marking of work.
- Teaching of PE/Sports Studies to students in line with the schemes of work and subject specifications as adopted within the department.
- Preparation and presentation of lessons of suitable content, level and interest to engage pupils throughout the age range.
- Keeping up to date with developments in the subject.
- Attendance at relevant courses to develop skills and knowledge appropriate to the teaching of the subject.
- Attendance at meetings as required by the Head of Department and senior leadership team.
- Attendance at (and contribution to) assemblies.

Assessing/recording/reporting:

- Assessing, recording and reporting on the development, progress and attainment of pupils.
- Setting of homework tasks in line with the homework timetable as prescribed by the Principal.
- Marking of pupils' work. Implementing Assessment for Learning strategies in line with the school's policy.
- Keeping records of the standard achieved by pupils in their work and using those records and other available data to set targets for pupils.
- Grading of pupils and writing of reports on pupils and to provide next steps to encourage student development and progression.
- Attendance at parents' evenings and meeting with parents.
- Maintenance of discipline and an atmosphere which is conducive to learning during lessons.
- Promoting the general progress and well-being of the individual class.
- Supervisory duties during break and/or lunchtime.
- Playing a part in the extra-curricular life of the school.

Other:

- To be aware of the School's policy on Child Protection.
- To assist at school functions and with extra-curricular activities.
- Attendance at Open Evening events to supervise pupils performing practical work and to speak to parents and prospective pupils.
- To carry out all teaching responsibilities as assigned.
- To perform such other duties as may be required by the Principal.
